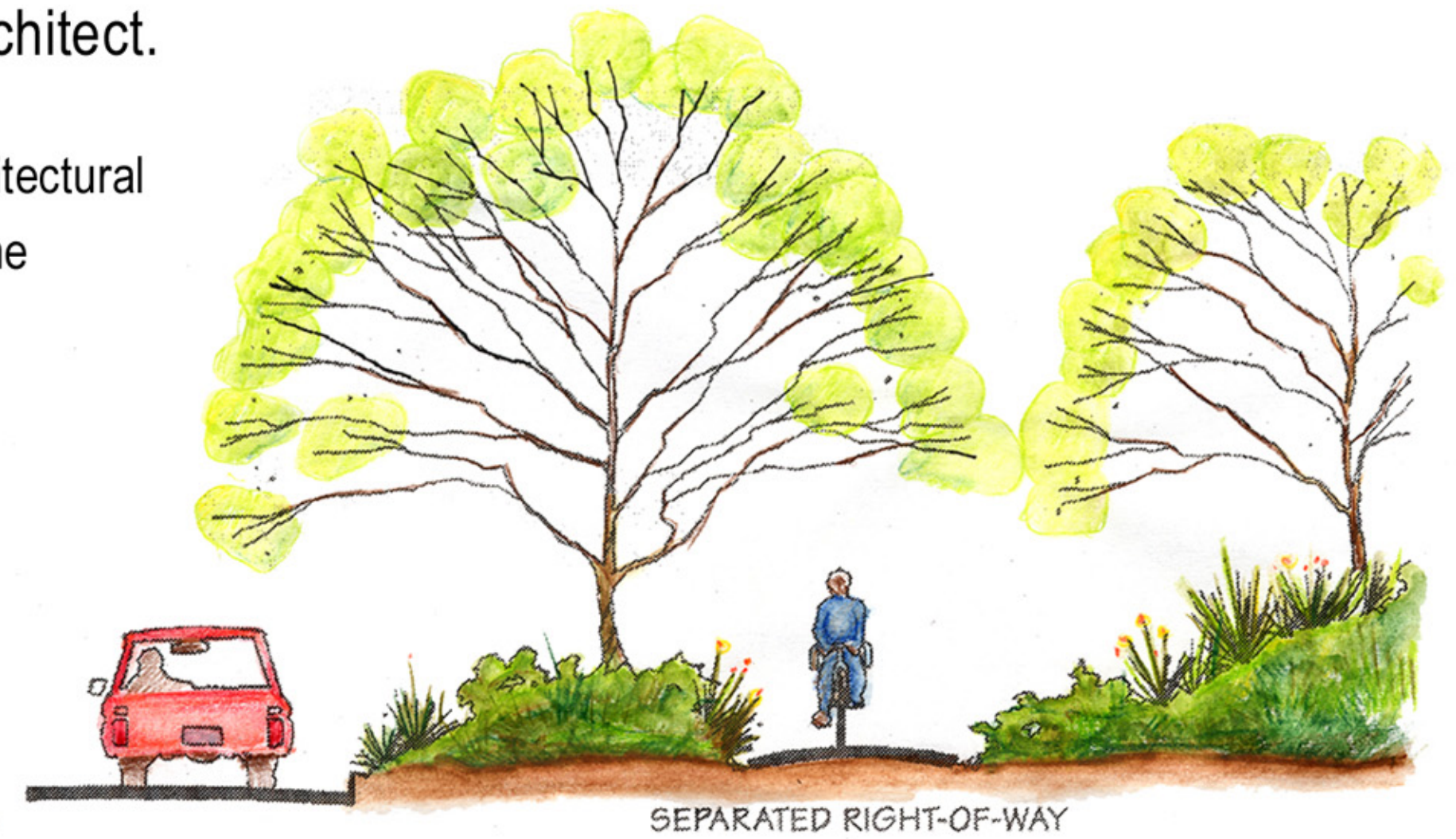


## FOSTERING CIVIC PRIDE THROUGH LIGHT

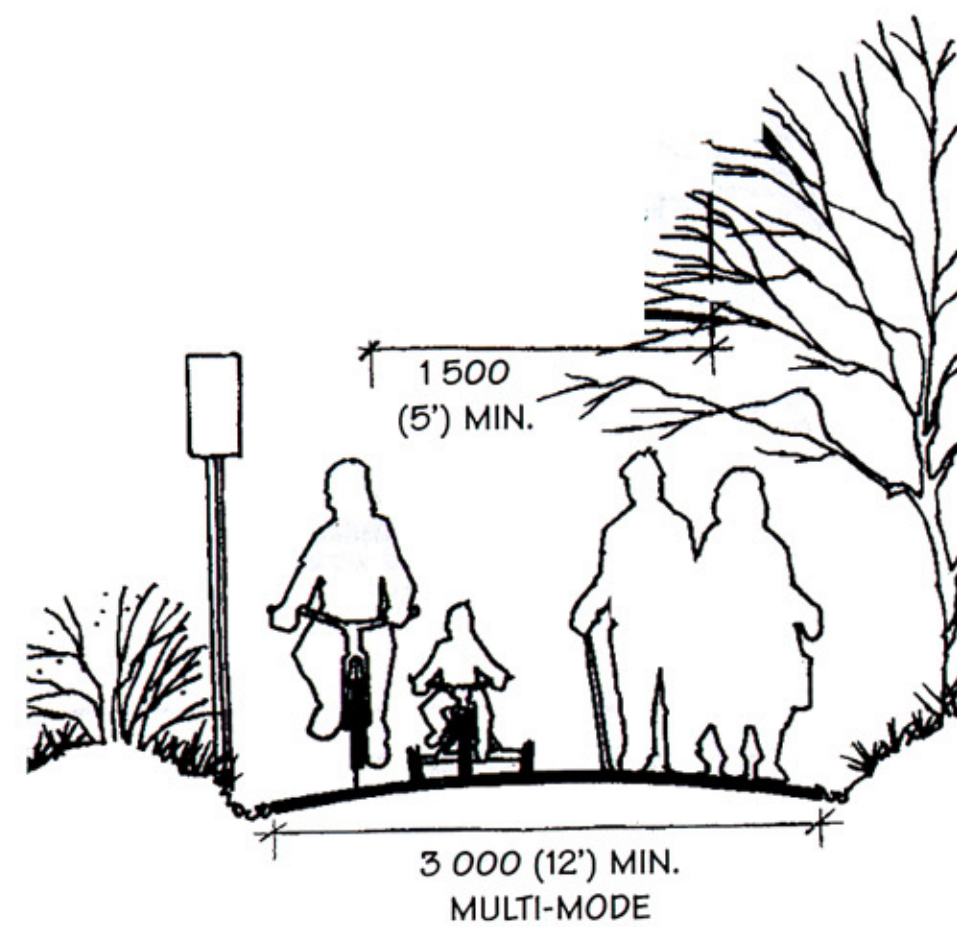

## SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL CALIFORNIA (1999)

Funded projects include new crosswalks, pedestrian and bicycle paths, bike lanes, sidewalks in neighborhoods where none were built, and "traffic calming" efforts in neighborhoods around schools to slow the speed of cars and enhance walkability.



## SMART NEIGHBORHOODS, WALKABLE COMMUNITIES MINNESOTA (2000)

Six "opportunity sites" received intensive help to create neighborhoods that are more convenient, walkable, and transit-friendly. Two of the sites are greenfields, three are older established suburbs, and one is located in the urban core.
